

Food Declaration

Natural, yellow, green, re/brown, bright red, blue and black

We, Partwell, declare that in the above mentioned products the used momomers for the manufacturing are listed in the EU-Directive 2002/72/EC (which is a revision of 90/128/EEC including the following 7 amendments: 92/39/EEC, 93/9/EEC, 95/3/EC, 96/11/EC, 99/91/EC, 2001/62/EC, 2002/17/EC).

The additives employed comply in respect of species, quantity and purity with the incomplete list of additives of EU-directive 2002/72/EC.

EC- Regulation No. 1935/20004 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 October 2004 on materials and articles intended to come into contact with food.

The above mentioned products comply also with the Code of Federal Regulations Title 21,§ 177.1520 "Olefin Polymers" of the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) of 1 April 2007 (in its valid version).

Plastics recommendations are not legal norms. They do, however, represent the current level of science and technology for the conditions under which consumer goods made of high polymer substances meet the requirements of § 31, para 1, LFGB (Article 3 para 1 a of the EC Regulation 1935/2004) in respect of their health safety. According to these provisions, materials and articles that come into contact with food are to be produced in compliance with good manufacturing practice in such a way that, under normal or foreseeable conditions of use, they do not transfer their constituents to foods in quantities which could endanger human health. If consumer goods are produced in a manner that deviates from their provisions in these recommendations, responsibility for any complaints on food law provisions (§§ 30, 31 para 1 LFGB) lies solely with the manufacturer and user.
